Notes

Annual Subscriptions are due in October and should be completed and returned as soon as possible in order to allow our Treasurer time to process and submit the various forms to YBKA, BBKA and BDI. Late payment may affect your BBKA and BDI insurance cover.

Our usual method of communication is by email; addresses and telephone numbers allow alternative or urgent communication.

For insurance and publication circulation purposes names and addresses of members are shared with both the YBKA and the BBKA.

In case of a disease problem near to your address or apiary, your details will be forwarded to the Beebase register. You are recommended to record the details of each of your out apiary locations, both permanent and temporary, on Beebase.
